We will continue to support your child at home when they are unable to attend school for any reason:

- ✓ National lockdown which may include school closure (**see the detailed plan on the back of the sheet**).
- ✓ Class bubble closed (**see the detailed plan on the back of the sheet**).
- ✓ Self-isolating (a pack of work will be sent home and children will receive weekly phone calls).
- ✓ Recovering from a long illness, but able to engage in work at home (a pack of work will be sent home and children will receive weekly phone calls).




We do not provide work for:

Reception Home Learning - Weekly Plan for Bubble or School Closure

Mrs Mayman and Miss Berry will:

- ✓ Provide THREE pre-recorded lessons per day which are detailed in the plan on the back of this sheet.
- ✓ Prepare work for your child that can be accessed virtually through your **Evidence Me App**. This will be differentiated to suit the needs of your child.
- ✓ Send an invitation for your child to access the daily lessons each morning. There will be short videos and explanation notes for you to help your child to complete the tasks set.
- ✓ Encourage you to use the **Parent Postcards** on **Evidence Me** to share any home learning experiences with your teachers.
- ✓ Invite your child to meet virtually with the class teacher and the rest of the class using **ZOOM**. We will text you the link and the details for this.
