Impact of leadership

Attainment:

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic it is clear that this has had a negative impact on the PE attainment across the school. Although there is a drop in the attainment it is **not** a significant drop. This gap in attainment should be recovered during the academic year of 2021/2022 with the current plans that we have in plans
