

Dear Parents/Carers,

Many thanks for completing and returning the recent Questionnaire which listed exactly the same questions used by Ofsted to gather parent opinion during our recent Inspection in March 2020. In March 2020 Ofsted received 43 parent responses which is only 14% of whole school.

This time, October 2021, we received **113** parent responses which is **36% of whole school** – thank you for your support.

As you can see the vast majority of parent responses provide a very positive picture of school.

I have selected two questions, highlighted in yellow, in order to provide parents with more information:

Q7) To let parents know how well their child is doing, school offers 3 Parent Consultations across the year (one each term). Additional meetings are set up for children/parents where this is required. If you feel you would like additional information about your child's progress, please call the school and we can arrange for the class teacher to call you or meet with you.

Q10) The school does a great deal to support pupil's wider personal development - we set up positions of responsibility such as: Team Captains, School Council and Junior Leadership Team. We build a School Curriculum which goes beyond the academic: PSHE lessons (Personal, Social, Health Ed), Outdoor Learning opportunities, Arts and Music, varied PE/Sports which includes opportunities to compete. We also arrange a huge variety of After School Clubs, arrange School Trips and visitors to school to lead workshops. In addition we encourage children to perform to build confidence and resilience, such as: class assemblies, year group productions, pantomimes, dance and musical performances.
