We are pleased to be able to offer afterschool sports clubs to our pupils. These will be offered on the dates shown below for the second half of the Spring term:

Children in years 1 to 4 will already be dressed in PE kit as the club is on the same day as their class PE lesson.

Y5/6 pupils attending on a Monday after school should bring appropriate PE uniform to wear to this session (dark shorts/track suit, white t shirt, dark trainers).

Please be advised that no specialist kit or clothing is required for these sessions.

The PE sessions are delivered by coaches from ACES who children see in their curriculum PE sessions.

The session will run until 4.20pm.

The after school sports sessions are offered as an enrichment opportunity and are open to all pupils to enjoy. Pupil behaviour expectations in these sessions are the same as those held in the school day. Pupils whose behaviour is persistently below this standard and preventing others from learning may be withdrawn from the sessions.

The afterschool clubs are very popular and places are limited. Please return the attached slip if you would like your child to attend the session. Places will then be allocated by the school office to ensure that – across the year – all children who wish to attend a sports club will have an opportunity to do so.

Slips should be returned to school by 9am on Tuesday 20th February. Places will be allocated and families will be contacted about the places by end of day on Thursday 22nd February.

The cost of the sessions is £10.00 (£2.50 per session) which should be paid upon registration using MCAS once you have received confirmation that your child has been allocated a place.
