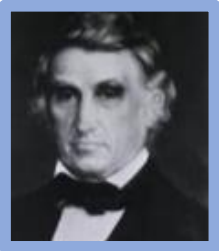

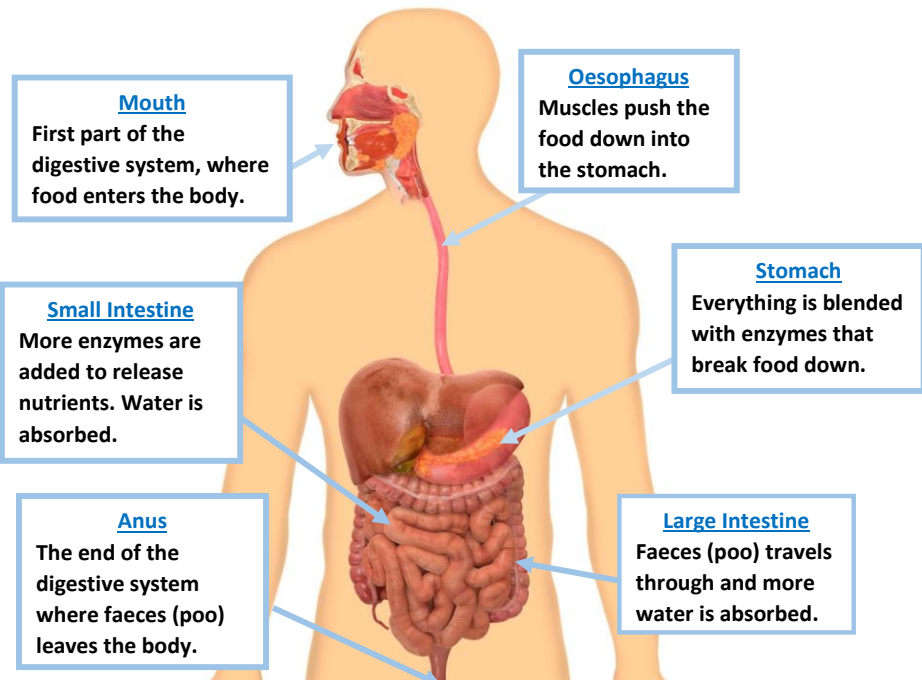


- Discovered that **food** is **broken down** by **enzymes**.

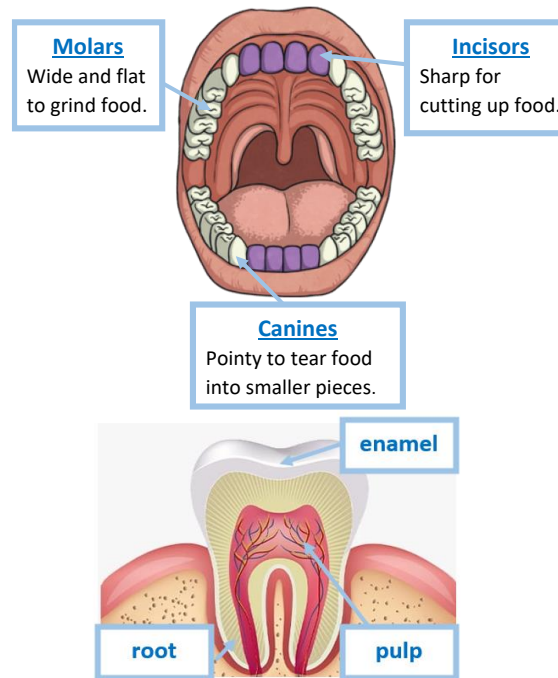

Big Ws: Teeth



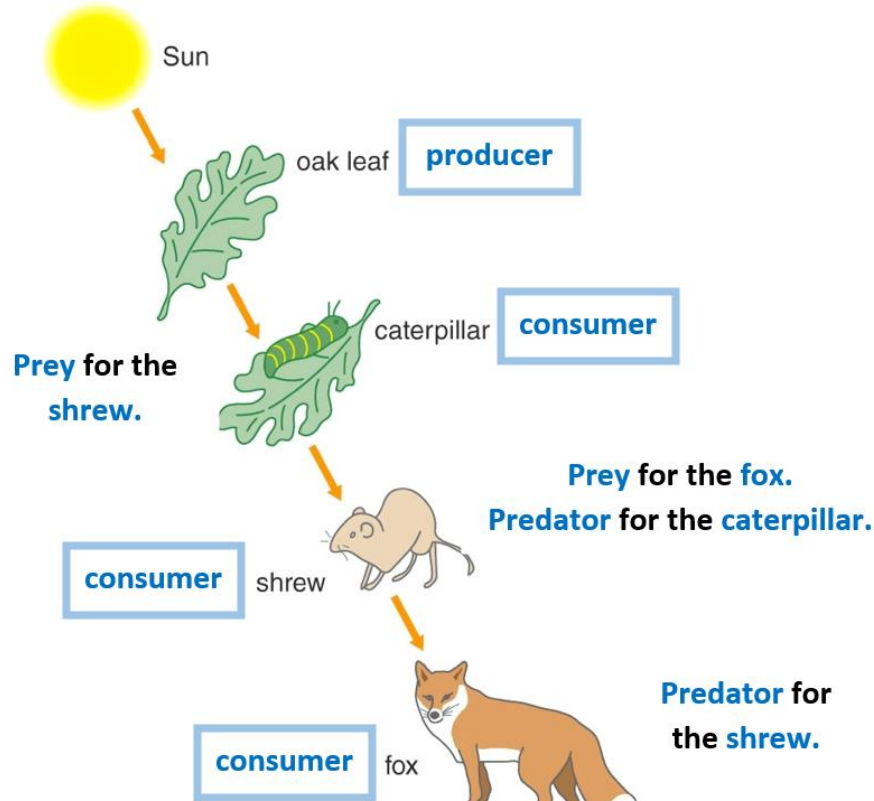
- **Brush** teeth **twice a day**.
- Visit the **dentist** regularly.



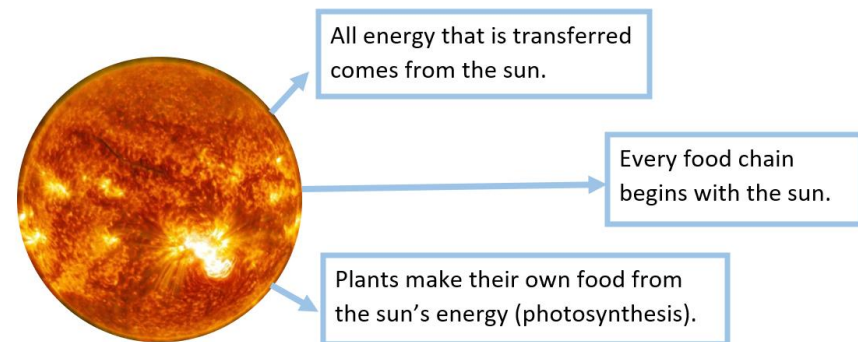
