

### **Big Ws: UK Politics**

#### **Big Ws: Henry VIII**



- Catholic originally, then became Protestant.
- Introduced the policy of the dissolution of the monasteries.
- Took land and money away from the Roman Catholic Church.
- Made himself the new head of the Church of England.

#### Big Ws: Civil War

Fought by Royalists (supporters of the Charles I) and
Parliamentarians (supporters of Parliament, led by Oliver

Cromwell).

- Led to 11 years of England not having a monarch.
- Charles I was executed.
