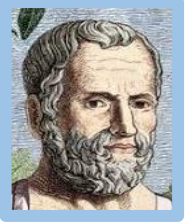





Important People

Theophrastus (371- 287BC)

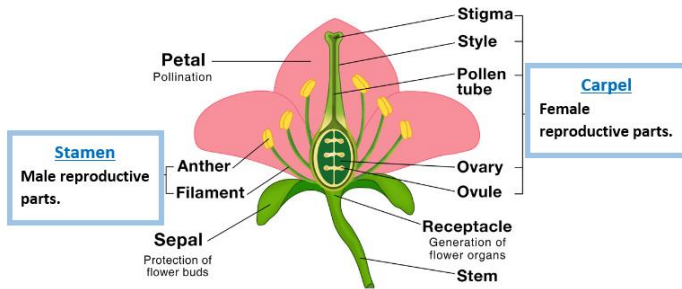


- Noticed a **plant could reproduce** from a **cutting** or by being **re-rotted**.
- Discovered **asexual reproduction**.

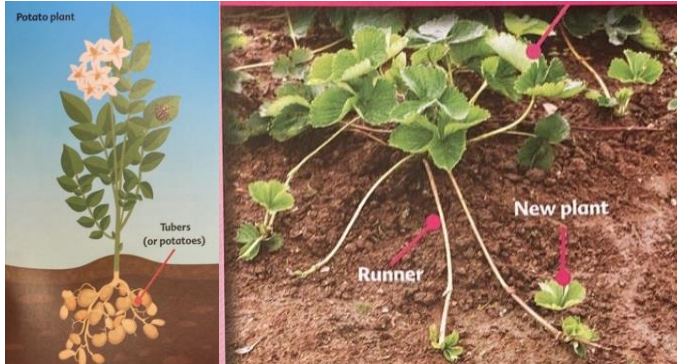

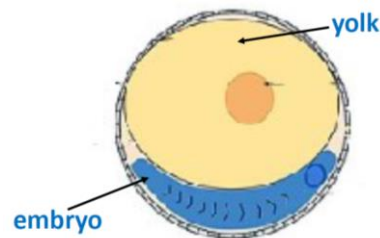
Big Ws: Plant Reproduction
